

PES DAY 2021 STUDENT POSTER CONTEST



(Region 1 Only)

CALL FOR POSTERS

PES Boston in partnership with **PES Day Global 2021** is inviting all Region 1 students and recent graduates to submit their Major Research Project Posters on topics related to Power & Energy. Students are encouraged to submit a 200-500 word abstract along with their poster. Registration is open to all Undergraduate (Bachelors) and Graduate (Masters, PhD) students attending schools within Region 1 territory (MA, RI, NH, VT, ME, CT, NJ, NY).

Posters will be scored based on a pre-determined scoring system from a carefully selected panel of judges from industry and academia located in Region 1. Two winning posters will be awarded the "PES Day 2021 Best Poster Award" and invited to present in front of a live audience at the upcoming PES Boston Technical Meeting on April 27th, 2021. These awards will each include the award certificate along with a \$200 gift card. All other posters will be briefly introduced during this session as well. This event will provide an excellent platform for students and recent graduates to showcase their work to industry professionals and possibly prospective employers in the Region 1 area and beyond.

PES Boston Professional Chapter is one of the largest and most active chapters in US and the world, having been recently recognized three times as the IEEE PES Outstanding Chapter Award (Large Chapter Category) worldwide.

Requirements:

- Undergraduate (Bachelors) or Graduate (Masters, PhD) Students graduating in 2021 or recent graduates of 2020.
- Attending University in Region 1 (MA, RI, NH, VT, ME, CT, NJ, NY).
- Poster subject related to Power & Energy, with the following requirements:
 - **Format**: PDF only, no other format will be accepted.
 - Naming convention: PESDAYBOS21_category*_lastname_poster-title.pdf *category refers to Grad (use G), Undergrad (use UG).
- Only one entry per project team allowed.
- Selected winners should prepare a 15-20 minute presentation in PowerPoint format.
