Applicant Tracking Software (ATS) or, the robots that do an initial read of your resume, are able to eliminate 75% of applicants.

Some tips for "beating the bots":

- Simple formatting -e.g. columns may make your resume difficult to scan
- Boldface and capital letters for section headings
- Look for keywords from the Job Qualifications AND the Job Responsibilities
- Use jargon and acronyms specific to your industry
- Integrate specific skills (like software programs, etc) into your descriptions of internships/projects, in addition to listing them in a skills section.
