## FAST FACTS

**90% of recruiters regularly use LinkedIn.** One study found that 122 million people received an interview through LinkedIn. Given these statistics, make sure your LinkedIn profile includes:

- A professional photo (this does not have to be professionally taken)
- A dynamic headline. E.g. "Sophomore Mechanical Engineer seeking Fall 2020 internship in R&D."
- Your About section completed (summary, etc)
- Your experiences, skills, and awards filled out
- At least 50 connections
- You being a member of at least 5 groups.

A Career Counselor can review your LinkedIn profile, help with the summary, and give you advice about networking on LinkedIn. You can make a virtual appointment with a Counselor on JobLink!

**What do we mean by Career Management? Identify and articulate one's skills, strengths, knowledge, and experiences relevant to the position desired and career goals, and identify areas necessary for professional growth. The individual is able to navigate and explore job options, understands and can take the steps necessary to pursue opportunities, and understands how to self-advocate for opportunities in the workplace.**

**Tips: Employers can assess your Career Management through:**

- **Attending information sessions**
- **Engaging in timely and professional follow-up**
- **If you have a professional online presence (LinkedIn)**
- **Your attention to detail on your resume and cover letter**
- **How you present yourself in an interview (demeanor, dress, tone, etc.)**
- **If you participate in continuing education such as conferences, research or outside of the classroom engagement**

The National Association of Colleges and Employers, through a task force of college career services and HR/staffing professionals, has developed a definition, based on extensive research among employers, and identified eight competencies associated with career readiness.
